Closing date for entries in the second annual open water swim, sponsored by the students of the University of Hawaii and the Outrigger Canoe club on Thanksgiving Day, November 28, at the Outrigger beach, is November 25, at 4 p. m. with graduate manager Theodore (Pump) Searle of the university.

Any swimmer duly registered with the AAU may enter the swim-fest. Outrigger canoes, paddle boats and launches will dot the beach on the day of the event. At stake is the Royal Hawaiian hotel special team trophy to the victorious organization. Besides, individual medals for winners of first, second and third places in the various events are being offered.

The events include the 1½ mile senior Castle swim, the half mile Public Baths swim and the quarter mile novice Cunha swim.

Last year the 40 and 8 club won the meet. The University of Hawaii, Hui Makani, Outrigger Canoe club and the Army were also represented in the swims.
