

Announce Events For 1932 Thanksgiving Day Swims

Gay Harris, head of the committee in charge of swimming at the Outrigger Canoe club, this morning announced the events which his organization will stage on Thanksgiving Day, a week from tomorrow, at Waikiki.

Besides the usual six races, an open or free for all affair will be included in the annual aquatic program. This is a race over the same course as the Castle swim for men, slightly over a mile, and anyone from any club is eligible to compete.

The other events, which will be for members of the Outrigger club only, are:

1. Castle's swim for men, trophy donated by Harold Castle.

2. Public bath's swim for women, trophy donated by The Star-Bulletin.

3. Public bath's swim for boys

under 18, trophy donated by Dawkins, Benny, Ltd.

4. Cunha's swim for boys under 16, trophy donated by A. R. Cunha.

5. Cunha's swim for girls, novice, trophy donated by Alexander Hume Ford.

6. Open event, same course as Castle's swim, trophy to be donated.

7. Public bath's swim for men over 30, trophy to be donated.

Harris requests that all entries be filed with him at the Outrigger Canoe club before noon Sunday.

According to reports from the club, more than 40 members, both boys and girls, have started intensive training. Good times are expected to be chalked up by the contestants.
