

# Jackie May Victor In Castle Race At Waikiki

## Annual Outrigger Carnival Hard Fought, Many Upsets

**G**LIDING through the gentle waves of Waikiki with powerful strokes, Jackie May, one of the greatest long distance swimmers in Hawaii at the present time, outdistanced his rivals by more than 60 yards to win the Castle swim, Thursday morning in the annual Outrigger Club Thanksgiving Day swimming meet.

May was in tip-top condition—no question about it. He withstood the grueling ordeal well and at the finish appeared to be fresh enough to enter another long distance grind. His time was 32 minutes 24 seconds.

Forging into the lead with the bark of the starter's gun at the Elks club, the Hui Makani star never was overtaken or even pressed in the hectic race to the finish line in front of the Outrigger club. He kept increasing the lead steadily as the race progressed and was fully over 60 yards ahead of Howard Kisner who finished second. Wilbur Craw was third. Two latter swimmers put up a game exhibition but it was beyond their task to try to outdo Jack May.

### MISS CLARKE WINS

In the Women's Open event, from the Public Baths to the Outrigger club, Miss Olga Clarke displayed too much flash and form for the other competitors. She won without much effort, for, like May, she was not forced to extend herself. The time was 22 minutes 57 2-5 seconds. Dorothy Hammond and Thelma Pope crossed the finish line second and third, respectively.

Gay Harris, one time Olympic star, won the race for men over 30 years of age. He showed his old time form and beat Bob Askew to the tape. Clifford Gessler was third. The winning time was 25 minutes 20 3-5 seconds.

In the event for boys under 16 years of age, Bob McWayne won with the time of 12 minutes 35 seconds. Ben Hollinger was second. Jimmie Hurd won from George Hogan in 23 minutes 19 3-5 seconds in the race for boys under 18.

Gladys Slaght crawled in first in the Girl's Novice race, her time being 14 minutes 12 3-5 seconds. Jean Pope was second and A. Delaney third.
