SENIOR EVENT

Four Other Cups At Stake; O. C. C. Will Present Medals To All Winners

Official list of prizes for winners of the annual open water swimming championships on Thanksgiving Day morning, sponsored by the Outrigger Canoe club, was announced today by John Barnes, manager of that organization.

To date there will be five trophies for the six events. Except for the swim for men over 30, all the races will see a cup at stake. The Star-Bulletin is donating a handsome silver cup to the winner of the women's public bath event. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first three winners in every event by the Outrigger Canoe club.

The list of trophies is:

Al Castle's cup—winner of the Castle swim, mile and one-fourth.

Alexander Hume Ford's cup—winner of boys under 16, one-fourth mile.

Alexander Hume Ford's Cup—Winner of girls' novice event, one-fourth mile.

Honolulu Star-Bulletin Cup—Winner of women's (senior) public bath swim, mile and one-fourth.

Dawkins, Benny—Winner of boys under 18 swim, three-fourth mile.

Gold Medals—First place winners.

Silver Medals—Second place winners.

Bronze Medals—Third place winners.

Want Cup Here

"To make the program a greater success," Manager John Barnes said, "somebody ought to do a good turn and donate a cup to the winner of the event for men over 30. Year after year they paddle their weary bodies through the rough water but get nothing but a medal. The distance is about three-fourths of a mile and it is a hard swim."

To date the entry list shows some of the best swimmers entered. In the Castle swim such stars as Buddy Crabbe, Tom Ellis, Gay Harris, A. E. Minvielle and M. Dease are entered. "Wild Bill" Harris, who returned from the Orient recently, announced that he is vying for honors. He is one of the oldtimers.
