

THREE CHAMPIONS WILL COMPETE FOR CASTLE CUP PRIZE

Mariechen Wehslau Also Entered in Women's Blue Ribbon Event; Best Swimmers of Club to Compete in Big Turkey Day Splash

ALL is in readiness for the annual Thanksgiving day Outrigger club's closed swim with the blue ribbon event a mile and one-half splash from the Public Baths to an anchored canoe just off the Outrigger quarters, in which are entered two former Olympic stars, Alberto Zorilla and Walter Laufer, with Buster Crabbe, the local and A.A.U. champion, to dispute the way.

Up to date more than 40 swimmers have entered the Turkey Day races. They include such aquatic aces of international fame as Clarence "Buster" Crabbe, national one mile freestyle champion; Walter Laufer, national indoor all-round titleholder of 1926; Alberto Zorilla, member of Argentina's Olympic swimming team of 1924; Eddie "Bud" Crabbe, new Hawaiian 100 meters freestyle winner; Sam Kahanamoku, former island champion sprint swimmer, and William Newport, winner of the 220 yards freestyle, boys under 18 event at the recent National A. A. U. Outdoor Aquatic carnival staged at the Waikiki War Memorial natatorium.

Among the leading women candidates are Miss Mariechen Wehslau, American record holder of the women's 220 yards freestyle event with a time of 2:42 2-5 seconds and Miss Cecily Cunha, Southern California's all-round mermaid.

The Thanksgiving Day swim program, which is scheduled to commence at 9 a. m., will be composed of six events. The entry list, which is open only to members of the Outrigger Canoe club, will close on Wednesday, November 23, or the day before the meet. Five handsome trophies will be awarded to the winners.
