

# OUTRIGGER REGATTA TO BE BIG AFFAIR

## Aquatic Sports To Begin Next Saturday—Entries Will Close Tomorrow

In the swimming meet held Saturday evening in the Y. M. C. A. tank Miss Madeline Chapin proved easily that she is the best woman swimmer in the Islands. She is a member of the Outrigger Canoe Club and will be starred in the coming month's meet of the popular Waikiki aquatic organization.

Mis Chapin scored fourteen points in Saturday's meet and in her plunge for distance came within twelve inches of the distance made by her brother, who is the best plunge-for-distance man in the Outrigger outfit.

W. S. Bench leaves for the Coast today. He is known as the father of the Outrigger Regatta, which will begin next Saturday out at the beach in Waikiki. He took the initiative in promoting the regatta and has been a most efficient worker in forwarding it. During his stay of two years in Honolulu he has been an enthusiastic swimmer and a patron of all aquatic sports.

### All Outriggerites to Compete

He held out at the outset that the only way to discover the talent possessed by the Outrigger would be to hold a regatta in which all the members would be able to enter and compete. His wisdom is thus early beginning to bear fruit.

Last Saturday and Sunday the surf was running well at Waikiki and there were many surfboard riders out getting in shape for this important feature of the coming regatta. The sailing canoes were also out and the boys and girls who will be competitors profited by the experience gained.

The main event in the coming Saturday's program, judged from the point of view of the older Outriggerists, will be the swim from Castle's Point to the Outrigger diving stand. Entries for the entire month's meet will close tomorrow.

### Big Chowder and Dance Coming

The Outrigger Canoe Club, as a whole, seems to be looking forward to Saturday evening, December 1, with more than ordinary interest, for at that time there will be a monster chowder given, which will be followed by a dance. The chowder and dance will follow the order of the one which took place at the opening of the new pavilion.

The regatta program will be held next Saturday, with the sailing races on Sunday following, and on Saturday, November 10; Sunday, November 18; and the Saturdays of November 24 and December 1.

The program for next Saturday will be as follows:

### Saturday's Program

Fifty-yard dash for women.

Twenty-five-yard dash for girls under twelve years.

Fifty-yard dash for men, novice.

Hundred-yard race for girls under fifteen years.

Hundred-yard breaststroke for women.

Swim from Castle Point to Outrigger diving stand, for elderly members.

Swim from Castle Point to Outrigger diving stand, for junior and senior members.

Sunday—Sailing race, triangular course off surf at Waikiki.

Winners in all events during the month's regatta will be awarded gold medals. Silver and bronze medals will be given to those finishing second and third in each event.
