

TRIALS TODAY IN MANY EVENTS ON TRACK MEET LIST

Outrigger, University and Palama Teams Expected To Show Strength

Trials for the annual A. A. U. championship track and field meet were scheduled to be run off at 4 p. m. today at Alexander field. The meet will be held on the same field Saturday afternoon.

The dopesters are still giving the Palama, Outrigger and University teams a chance to win the meet but the Outriggers appear to be favorites.

The Army is expected to grab off a number of points but chances of the service athletes to win the meet dropped considerably when at least one of the stars, Kahler, failed to file his entry blank on time.

The Outrigger club will be represented by the same men who were in the Rainbow Relay Carnival last Saturday. This will give them an advantage over Palama in the sprints. However, French of the Army may surprise the locals by grabbing off first or second in the sprints.

Palama will no doubt cop many points in the field and pit events and will also have strong entries in the distance runs. Here, again, the Army may jump to the front with Cerney having a very good chance to take first place in the distance events.

No heats will be run off Saturday, arrangements having been made to take care of all semi-finals today. Finals will be held today in one event, the hammer throw.

It is planned to conduct the trials and finals the same as other meets staged here this year which means that only the officials will be allowed on the field while the meet is in progress.

The entry list for the meet is the largest that has been filed for any track and field event here. The athletes are in good condition, having been performing in meets for several weeks, and several records are expected to fall.
