

# LANES ARE DRAWN FOR RAINBOW RELAY RACES

Drawings for lanes for the relay events at the Rainbow Carnival tomorrow took place yesterday. While the Deans got the jump in the trials, the Pals came back strong in the drawings when "Dusky" Brash picked two poles, three number twos and a single three.

The following is the way the teams will lineup in the various relays tomorrow at Kam field from the pole to the sixth lane:

**Quarter-mile Relay**—Outrigger, Palama, Army, Guard, and Varsity.

**Half-mile Relay**—Guard, Army, Palama, Varsity, Outrigger.

**Mile Relay**—Varsity, Palama, Army, Guard.

**Two-mile Relay**—Palama, Outrigger, Varsity, Guard, Army.

**Four-mile Relay**—Palama, Varsity, Outrigger, Guard, Army, Central "Y."

**Medley Relay**—Outrigger, Palama, Guard, Army, Varsity.

The teams will run in lanes in the quarter-mile and half-mile relays and will fight for the pole in the other relays with the exception of the medley where the first two, sprint laps, will be run in lanes.

The teams will change batons in the lanes in which they started each race, irrespective of whether the entire race is run in lanes. This is the A. A. U. custom according to the rule book.
