

RAINBOW TRACK MEET PLANNED APRIL 10TH A. A. U. GAMES MAY 3

Committee Expected to Sanction Two Big Outdoor
Carnivals This Spring; Scholz,
Hahn to Compete

THE University of Hawaii annual rainbow track and field meet will be held on April 10 and the A. A. U. track and field meet on May 3 if these dates are satisfactory to the track and field committee of the Hawaiian Amateur Athletic Union, of which Victor Ligda is chairman.

A meeting of the committee has been called for 1 o'clock Saturday afternoon in the Y. M. C. A., when the proposed meets will be sanctioned unless there is unforeseen opposition. The committee includes besides Ligda, Otto Klum, Univer-
