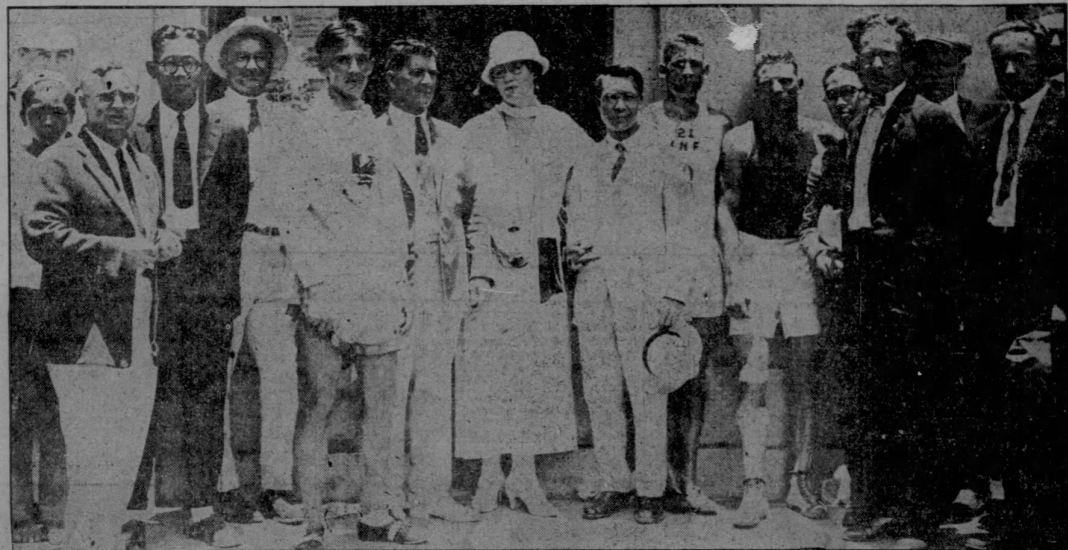
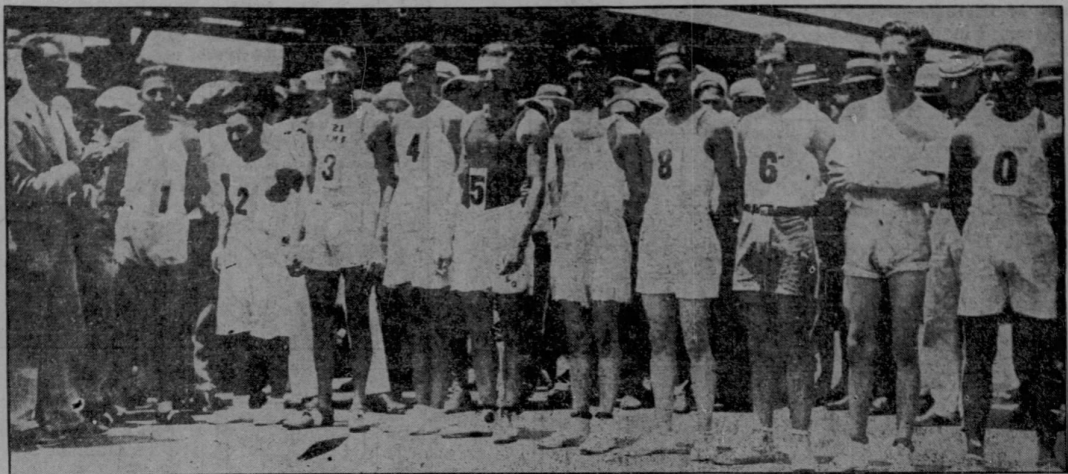


CONTESTANTS AND OFFICIALS OF MARATHON RACE YESTERDAY
