

# HILO ATHLETES HAVE EDGE IN TRACK MEETING

## Score 75 Points To Honolulu's 50 Breaking One Hawai- ian Record

HILO, July 6.—(By Airplane to The Advertiser)—Repeating her aquatic triumphs on the slender path and in the field, Hilo captured the athletic meet Saturday, scoring 75 points to an even 50 for Honolulu and 3 for unattached contenders. Nine firsts, eight seconds and seven thirds tell the story of the superiority of the Crescent City athletes over the visitors. The only new record was made in the shot put when Joe Kawaha hurled the leaden sphere 41 ft. 11½ inches, breaking the previous Island record of 40 ft. 7 ins.

**100 Yards**—K. A. Decker, first; Chu Fook Fong, second; Chu Fook Tang, third; Asoy Afook, fourth. Time, 10 seconds.

**Throwing the Discus**—K. Kanakaole, 101 feet, 1½ inches, first; George Ruttman, 96 feet, 4¾ inches, second; Louis Kanaho, 88 feet, 3 inches.

### **Mile Time Slow**

**One Mile Race**—G. Canario, first; W. H. Meinecke, second; A. P. Helbush, third. Time 5 minutes, 53.5 seconds. Meinecke took the lead at the start, with G. Canario second, and with Ishimura third, but in the third lap Helbush displaced Ishimura.

**220 Yards Dash**—Kenneth A. Decker, first; Chu Fook Fong, second; Joe Stickney, third, and Asoy Afook fourth. Time 25 seconds.

**Pole Vault**—G. Canario, first; Harold Harvey, second; Allen Akana, third. Canario and Harvey both cleared the bar at 10 feet 1 inch. Akana cleared it at 9 feet 6 inches.

**120 High Hurdles**—A. I. Afook, first; Asoy Afook, second; Wm. Leal, third. Time 18.25 seconds. This race was run in two heats, four men to a heat.

**Javelin Throw**—This was not completed, as the javelin was broken in the air by Wm. Leal. K. Kanakaole had thrown it 116 feet 2¼ inches in his first attempt.

### **Quarter Is Speedy**

**440 Yards Dash**—Joe Stickney, first; Leonard Carlsmith, second; Charlie Lambert, third. Time 57.25 seconds.

**Running Broad Jump**—Chu Fook Fong, 20 feet, first; William Leal, 19 feet 6¼ inches, second; Harold Harvey, 18 feet 5½ inches, third.

**5-Mile Race**—A. S. Medeiros, first; A. P. Helbush, second; W. H. Meinecke, third. The winner's time was 32 minutes, 46.35 seconds.

**Running High Jump**—W. W. Carter, 5 feet 1 inch, first; Henry O. Lai Hip, 5 feet 1 inch, second, and Chu Fook Fong, 5 feet, third. Both Carter and Lai Hip, Hilo boys, cleared the bar at 5 feet 1 inch and then decided to stop, tossing up for first place.

**Hop, Step and Jump**—Lionel Silva, 38 feet, 2 inches, first; G. Canario, 38 feet, 1 inch, second; W. W. Carter, 37 feet, third.

**880 Yards Dash**—G. D. Crozier, first; Leonard Carlsmith, second; Joe Stickney, third. Time 2 minutes, 15.15 seconds. Won by two yards.

**Half-mile Relay Race**—Four men on a side, each to run 220 yards. Won by Hilo. Time 2 minutes, 43½ seconds.
