Soccer Players Wel- come Addition to the Ranks

THE first representation from Pearl Harbor in the local soccer series will be on next Saturday. Whether the team at that time will be a harbor team or one made up purely of marines remains to be seen, the matter to be settled finally later this week. However, the harbor will be on the job Saturday, and in its initial effort will tackle the Palama outfit. The other game of the pair scheduled for the week-end contest will be between the Rangers and Outriggers. This will inaugurate the regular session of the Honolulu Soccer League.

The local soccer people are enthusiastic over the advent of the harbor players in the competitions here. Jack Rosemond of the Outrigger team has already volunteered his services as a coach or for any purpose in which he may be of assistance to the sailors.
