

RECORD TURNOUT IS FIGURED FOR SOCCER

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, H. T., Feb. 17.—Officials predict an island's record for attendance at a soccer match when the Outriggers of Honolulu and Schofield XI meet here Sunday afternoon for the championship of the island in the final big game of the association series.

Over 5000 service men in the post are expected to attend.
