

# Basketers of Nevada To Be Matched With Local Champs

Team That Defeated Pacific Coast Conference Champions To Perform At Armory

The University of Nevada's basketball team, which won the Pacific Coast Championship last season when it defeated Stanford 25 to 19, will play the winners of the 1919 championship in Hawaii.

The five members of the title holding squad from the Silver-state are all with the Nevada football team on its trip to the islands and Percy Nottage, head of the Honolulu Basketball Association and manager of the Oahu Sporting Goods Company, is arranging for at least two games for the visitors.

Three members of the Nevada team, Bradshaw (guard), Buckman (center) and Waite (forward) were chosen for the All-California-Nevada team. Waite is conceded to be one of the most capable pieces of basketball machinery in the game today.

## Play Two Games

The games, if present plans are finally accepted, will be staged at the National Guard Armory on Wednesday, December 29, and Tuesday, January 4. The teams that will probably play will be the National Guard team, champions in the service and A. A. U. leagues for 1919-20, and the Outrigger canoe club team, runners up in the A. A. U. league. The games will start at 8 o'clock in the evening.

Nevada holds a splendid record for last season at basketball. Not one of the inter-college games was lost and the only team that was able to defeat the Nevadans was the Los Angeles Blues, National Champions of the A. A. U. basketball league. This team captured two games.

## The Records

The college games played last season were as follows:

Three other games, non schedule, were won by the Nevadans.

The championship status of the team is acquired by the defeat administered to the Stanfordites, who were champions of the Pacific Coast conference in basketball. Sports authorities on the coast were agreed that this victory gave the Nevadans the title.
