Two Paddle Canoe Race.—This race may have to be run in heats for the reason that there are only six available small canoes. Prizes: First, two spruce paddles; second, two N.W. paddles; third, tickets for the entertainment.

Three Paddle Canoe Race.—Prizes: First, three spruce paddles; second, three N.W. paddles; third, tickets for the entertainment.

One Paddle Canoe Race.—Prizes: First, cup; second, spruce paddle; third, one N.W. paddle; fourth, ticket for entertainment.
