

PHONES TO TELL RESULTS OF RACES ON REGATTA DAY

Public Will Be Informed
Almost Immediately of
Outcome In Contests

A system of telephones through which the results of the Regatta Day races will be announced has been arranged by the rowing association and the regatta committee in order that the public may learn the outcome of the events almost immediately.

A telephone will be installed on Pier 9, the starting and finishing point of the race, and another on Pier 2. From Pier 2 to Pier 9 the position of the barges at the turn will be telephoned and announced on the latter pier by megaphone.

At the finish Pier 9 will notify Pier 2 of the result, the final placing of the boats being announced by megaphone on the seaward side of the pier. It was originally planned to use flags in following the progress of the races, but this method was later discarded.

Arrangements have been made on Pier 9 to seat 2000 with 456 general admission seats on Pier 7. A limit of 100 autos will be allowed on Pier 2.

Saturday's races include 11 events: Girls' special race, kids under 18, girls, senior and junior, boys' novice, senior $1\frac{3}{4}$ miles, Outrigger canoe race, junior, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles, freshmen, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles.

Yacht race, seven entries, intermediate.

Hilo is sending four crews, senior, junior, freshmen and kid, which will arrive here September 18 and sail for the Big Island September 21.
