

MARIECHEN TO BE HOME TOMORROW

Hawaii's Girl Swimmer To Be Welcomed Home Aft- er Tour of U. S.

Mariechen Wehselau, Hawaii's champion girl swimmer, will return on the Aorangi tomorrow after several months' visit on the mainland during which she competed in several big swimming meets. She is accompanied by Mrs. E. Fullard-Leo, chaperon.

Miss Wehselau entered the 50, 100 and 220 yard events at the women's national championship meet held at St. Augustine, Florida, in February. She placed in two of the races and in the trials set a new world's mark in the 220 which, however, was broken in the finals. Before leaving Vancouver last week Miss Wehselau clipped six seconds off the Canadian record for the Century swim.

Mrs. Leo will give a full report on their trip at the regular monthly meeting of the A. A. U. tomorrow evening.
