Center expressed himself as optimistic over the future of these lads and gave us the main cause lying behind the coming Outrigger club swimming meet.

"While we are anxious to have every outstanding swimmer in the islands take part in the coming meet with the Far Eastern champions, the meet was arranged primarily for these youngsters who have demonstrated that they are capable of performing in fast company," said the nationally famous coach.

"We can write about these lads and can tell the mainland how good they are, but until they compete against swimmers of known ability, we will not be taken seriously by A.A.U. officials. If they can display sufficient ability in the coming meet, I feel sure that in the future Hawaii will be recognized by the national body more so than it is now," said Center.
