J. R. Farrington, representing the Outrigger Canoe Club, also spoke. He declared that the club had a membership of more than 1100 persons, approximately 750 of them being men, and that the club was strongly in favor of the plan to reclaim the beach. "As many as three to four hundred of our members use the beach in one day," said Farrington. "We are very much in favor of seeing the beach developed and will give

our support toward the accomplish-

ment of that purpose."
