

JAPAN WINS TWO-DAY MEET WITH HAWAII

Local Mermen Score
16 Points to Win-
ners' 26

THREE WORLD'S RECORDS BROKEN

Japanese Team Sets
New Mark in 800
Meter Relay

TOKIO, Sept. 8.—(Wednesday)—Japan defeated Hawaii in the two-day swimming meet complete here this afternoon. The total points at the end of the inter-nation meet were Japan 26, Hawaii 16. Yesterday's meet resulted in Japan taking 14 points, and the visitors 7. Today the local team piled up 12 points to Hawaii's 9.

Three world's records fell in the meet. Yesterday Warren Kealoha flashed over the line in the 400 meter backstroke in six minutes and one second. This was in an exhibition event. Today the Japanese lads established a new mark in the 800 meter relay. The time was 9 minutes, 38 1-5 seconds. Takaishi swam the 200 meters freestyle event in 2 minutes, 10 4-5 seconds. This is believed to be a new world mark for the swim in a 50 meter pool.
