

FORMER HONOLULU BOY GRABS HONORS IN MAINLAND SWIM

Ernest Cook, formerly of Honolulu and a member of the Outrigger Canoe Club, recently won a mile and a half swimming race at Santa Barbara, California, according to word received by his friends here.

Cook finished 20 yards ahead of the second place winner, his time being 57 minutes 30 seconds. Seventeen swimmers started in a choppy sea that made swimming difficult and nine of them were forced to quit. Cook took the lead at the start and was 100 yards ahead at the half way mark.
