

DIVING CONTEST ON PROGRAM AT FORT DE RUSSY

Officials Decide Not To Hold High Diving At New Nata- torium Tonight

The plain high diving contest for national championship, which was scheduled to take place this evening at the Waikiki memorial pool as a part of the national swimming meet has been changed to Fort De Russey.

This change was made on account of the fact that the lighting at the memorial pool is not suitable for high diving, and also that the shallowness of the pool is such that some of the divers feel that upon diving from a great height they are apt to strike bottom.

Arrangements were made with army officials which permits the use of the Fort De Russey diving platform for this competition, and as there is 35 feet of water under this platform there is no danger of injury to any of the divers.

The contest will take place at 4 p. m. and arrangements have been made to accommodate as many spectators as desire to see it.

Changes to be made in the new pool after this meet will remedy the conditions which made this move necessary.
