For many years Duke Kahanamoku shattered one world's record after another. He was the champion of more than one Olmypiad and was hailed as the swimming phenomenon, bringing aquatic glory to the United States and especially to his own Hawaii.

Prospect that Duke again will appear at an Olmpiad was hailed with enthusiasm here today.
