A.A.U. Gives Him Clean
Bill of Health; Ready
to Battle Rivals

LOS ANGELES, Apr. 5.—Duke Kahanamoku, living symbol of the world's greatest swimming achievements, is to return to amateur competition. It is expected that he will compete for a place on the sprint swimming team which will represent the United States at the next Olympic games to be held this summer at Amsterdam.

The National Amateur Athletic union today notified Duke that he is to be reinstated as an amateur. His amateur standing was questioned a year ago when he appeared on a vaudeville circuit. Because he gave swimming exhibitions for pay Duke was suspended as an amateur and since has not been permitted to participate in amateur competition.
