

# HUI MAKANIS SCORE VICTORY IN SWIMMING

His time was 1 minute 25 3-5 seconds. The American record, held by Spence, is 1 minute 18 2-5 seconds.

Betty Hammond won the 100-meter breaststroke for women in a thrilling race with her sister, Virginia Hammond. Betty won by half a yard. Her time was 1 minute 46 4-5 seconds. The American record by A. Geraghty is 1 minute 33 seconds.

The race which brought the crowd to its feet was the 800-yard club relay. The Hui Makanis, chiefly through the brilliant performances of the two Kalili boys, Manuella and then Manola, beat the Outriggers by more than five yards at the finish. Eddie Crabbe gave the Outriggers the lead by beating Warren Kealoha of the Hui Makanis by eight yards. However, Bill Newport lost the lead and Manuella Kalili, giving the Hui Makani third man a good lead.

"Buster" Crabbe swam a great race trying to close the wide gap in the final lap, but only succeeded in cutting down the lead by about 12 yards.
