riechen and Lily get started O. K. None of the swimmers from the east except Halloran has come out yet. Halloran is at Stanford. Am hitting the hay at 9 p. m.

**Saturday May 26**—Went to Searsville lake today and the sun and the air hit closer to home than any spot here I have seen yet. The lake is about half a mile long with fresh water. It is 40 or 50 feet deep in places; so deep, in fact, that they have had to make an artificial bottom. The water was great, about 69 degrees. Had a good swim up there. Am going to Fleischhacker tomorrow morning. Hitting the hay at 9:30 p. m.

**Sunday May 27**—Up at 6:40 a. m. and took a swim. Had breakfast and at 9 o'clock we left for Fleischhacker pool and had a workout. This afternoon rode around the Presidio, Crissy Field and to the old fort on this side of the Golden Gate. It was quite windy. Had a dip at the club pool and then had dinner. Went to the Orpheum for the last time before the races. None of the swimmers from the east or from southern California has arrived yet. Am hitting the hay at 10:45 p. m.

**Monday, May 28**—Another day gone and I am glad of it. The quicker the meet comes the better. Gee, it seems as though I have been here for months. Got up this morning at 6:30 a. m. and had a swim. Then went to Fleishhacker at 10 o'clock. Had lunch at the Olympic club and then went to the big pool again. I will start to taper off training in a few days and will just take easy swims and build up before the races. Got a letter from Alberto Zorillo and he says that "Boy" Charlton is swimming great. Ruddy is not coming to the national championships. Neither is Glancy. They will go to Detroit early to practice. Kojac and Spence are the only entries here from the Metropolitan district. I think Clapp of the Hollywood A. C. will be the strong man in the mile swim unless some dark horse comes up. "Dad" Center got a wire from Johnny Woodd asking that he be entered in the nationals. Am turning in at 8:45 p. m.
