Duke Kahanamoku, one of the greatest human fish the swimming world has ever known, has given up all hopes of making this year's Olympic swimming team. This became known yesterday from close friends, who also announced that the peerless paddler had signed a movie contract with Samuel Goldwyn.

Until a recent attack of flu laid him low Kahanamoku had his heart set on making this year's United States team — his fourth in sixteen years of competition. But when illness struck him, interfering with his program of training, the Duke finally gave it up as hopeless.

"I trained six months for the Olympic Games in 1924," he said, "and even then my legs went bad on me. The boys are getting faster and faster and I am not getting any
