

BUSTER CRABBE WINS 300 METER MEDLEY CONTEST

Local Swimming Star Hangs Up Another National Swim Title After Name

SAN FRANCISCO, June 9.—Clarence "Buster" Crabbe of Honolulu won his second national swimming title here today by placing first in the 300-meter medley swim.

The race was one of the leading features of the third day of national championship swimming at the Fleishhacker pool here. The other leading feature was the 880-yard club relay for men, which like last year was won by the Illinois Athletic club team from Chicago.

Members of the winning relay team were Diphmar, O'Connor, Samson, and Weissmuller.

The summaries for today:

880-yard club relay, National A. A. U. championship—Illinois Athletic club, first; Olympic club, San Francisco, second; Hollywood Athletic club, third. Winner's time, nine minutes 32 3-5 seconds, a new world's record. Old record, 9:35, made by same team last year at Honolulu.

300-meter medley swim, national championship—Clarence Crabbe, Outrigger Canoe club, Honolulu, first; George Kojac, Boys' club, New York, second; Allan Cross, Erie, Pa., third. Winner's time, 4 minutes 16 seconds flat.
