

# Crabbe Swims 1500 Meters Race Today

DETROIT, Mich., June 22.—Fresh from his recent victories in San Francisco, where he established a new world's record for the mile at the National A. A. U. outdoor swimming championships, Clarence "Buster" Crabbe of the Outrigger Canoe club of Honolulu will compete in the 1500 meters race at the Olympic tryouts here tomorrow.

The 1500 meters event will be the feature of tomorrow's program at the Olympic tryouts. George "Dad" Center, cagey mentor of the Outrigger club, tonight declared himself more than satisfied with Crabbe's condition. He made no predictions for tomorrow, but he smiled confidently.

At the opening of the tryouts today Johnny Weismuller, "human fish" of the Illinois Athletic club, won the finals in the 100 meters race. Weismuller's time for the 100 meters was 58 4-5 seconds. He did not break a record since his time was one second slower than his own high mark for the event.

Johnny Woodd of the Central Y. M. C. A., Honolulu, finished fifth in the 100 meters today. George Kojac of the New York Boys' club was second. Walter Laufer of Chicago was third and John Bronson of the New York Athletic club was fourth. Paul Samson of the Illinois Athletic club was sixth.
