BUSTER CRABBE WINS FINALS IN 1500 METER SWIM

Local Aquatic Star Ends Race 30 Yards Ahead of Second Place Winner

DETROIT, Mich., June 23.—Clarence "Buster" Crabbe of the Outrigger Canoe club, Waikiki, Honolulu, today won the finals of the 1500 meter Olympic games tryout freestyle swim.

Crabbe finished in 20 minutes 49 3-5 seconds, 30 yards ahead of Ray Ruddy, 16-year old high school boy wearing the colors of the New

York Athletic club.

Ruddy finished second, and Austin Clapp, Hollywood, Cal., high school swimmer, third, about 30 yards behind Ruddy. All three won the right to represent the United States in the 1500-meter race this summer in the Olympic games at Amsterdam, Netherlands.
