*Martha Norelius In
World Record Win
In 400 Meters*

HOLM WINS

*Other Coast Stars
Will Perform
Today*

ROCKAWAY BEACH, L. I., June 30.—Miss Martha Norelius of New York broke her own world swimming record for the 400-meter free style when she defeated Miss Ethel McGary of New York by one foot in the Olympic tryouts in women's swimming here today. Her time was 5:49 3-5, and the former record was 5:51 2-5.

Miss Eleanor Holm of New York, 15-year-old girl, won the 100 meter back stroke in 1:25.

Miss Norelius also won the 440-yard National championship, held in conjunction with the 400 meter event. Her time was 5:49, also a new world's record. The tryouts will continue through Tuesday.
