

Honolulu Girl Gets Third In Medley Swim

Lily Bowmer May Places, Martha Norelius Smashes Three Records

ROCKAWAY, N. Y., July 3.—Three records were smashed today by Martha Norelius of the New York Women's Swimming association in the final events of the Olympic try-outs for women swimmers. During the 880 yards freestyle race Miss Norelius set a new mark of 11 minutes, 56 3-5 seconds for the half mile; 5 minutes, 51 2-5 seconds for the quarter mile and seven minutes, 22 4-5 seconds for the 500 meters.

Ethel McGary of New York was second in the 880 yards freestyle and Josephine McKim of Homestead, Pennsylvania, was third. Misses McGary and McKim each bettered the old record.

Eleanor Holm of New York won the 300 meters medley race. Her time, a new record, was 4 minutes and 56 seconds flat. Lisa Lindstrom was second and Lily Bowmer May of the Outrigger Canoe club, Honolulu, was third.

Helen Meaney of New York took the plain and fancy diving events and Miss Foley was second.
