

# *Buster To Clash With Champions*

Swims In 400 Meters To-  
day Against Borg and  
Charlton

**A**MSTERDAM, Holland,  
Aug. 8.—Clarence "Buster" Crabbe of the Out-  
rigger Canoe club, Honolulu,  
tomorrow will swim in the  
finals of the 400 meters free-  
style swimming race at the  
Olympic games here. The  
Honolulu merman will find  
himself pitted against such  
strong swimmers as Arne Borg  
of Sweden and Boy Charlton of  
Australia.

Today Borg won the second heat  
of the semi-finals of the 400 meters  
race. But Crabbe was close on his  
heels, finishing only one second be-  
hind the Swedish champion. Austin  
Clapp of the Hollywood Athletic club  
was third in this heat.

Borg covered the distance in five  
minutes, 5 2/5 seconds. Crabbe swam  
the 400 meters in five minutes, 6 2/5  
seconds while Clapp's time was five  
minutes, 6 4/5 seconds.

## ZORRILLA WINS HEAT

In the first heat of the 400 meters  
race, Alberto Zorrilla of Argentina  
finished first. He swam ahead of  
Boy Charlton of Australia who was  
second. Ray Ruddy of the New York  
Athletic club was third in this heat.

George Kojac, sensational young  
swimmer of the New York Boys' club,  
won the first heat of the semi-finals  
of the 100 meters backstroke event.
