

CRABBE ENTERS YALE AFTER THE OLYMPICS; NOT COMING HOME

CLARENCE (BUSTER) CRABBE, Hawaii's sole representative on the United States Olympic team faces another tough job today when he clashes against Boy Charleton of Australia and Arne Borg in the 440 meters swim. His time trials are much slower than he has done right here in Hawaii.

It was learned last night Buster would not return to his home on this island when the American team arrives in New York, but would proceed direct to New Haven where he has enrolled at Yale University for the coming year. He will, of course, be a candidate for the Yale Freshman swimming team this Fall and will be eligible for the 'varsity the following year.

This means that Buster's friends will not see him until he returns home for the 1929 summer vacation.
