

Large Crowd Is Expected At Fifth Annual Surfboard Program Tomorrow

Many Records Are Due To Be Broken; Large Entry List In Every Event; Programs Will Be Passed To Fans; No Admission Is Made To New Year's Morning Program

All roads will point to the Wai-iki canal tomorrow morning and if the big interest keeps up, more roads will be needed to take care of the large crowd anticipated in the fifth annual New Year's Day surfboard paddling program which starts at 9:30 sharp. No admission is charged. Programs will be issued.

A record entry list has been received by the committee in charge and every record is expected to go by the boards. The annual program is being staged by the Shell Co. of California under the direction of the Outrigger Canoe club and Dawkins, Benny.

Beatrice Newport, present quarter-mile woman champion, is aiming to reduce her old record of 3 minutes 49 1-5 seconds, made in 1926.

In the 100-yard men's open event, Champion T. Kiakona, paddling under the Hui Nalu colors, will endeavor to maintain his place as Hawaii's fastest 100-yard paddler, and to lower his own record of 40 1-5 seconds for the event, which he made last year.
