

Life Saving Station Plan of Outrigger

Within the next few days the Outrigger Canoe Club will establish a life saving station on the beach at Waikiki, it was learned yesterday through Lorrin P. Thurston, president of the club.

At the Thursday night meeting the directors of the club unanimously adopted a motion of George D. "Dad" Center that as soon as possible the club install a loud electric alarm gong at some beach vantage point together with canoe crews and essential life saving equipment to give aid to stranded bathers and motorboat enthusiasts.

Within the past few weeks, according to Thurston, Center has gone to the aid of several parties whose boats have been swamped in the surf.

"Dad seemed to think that such an aid station would be a pretty fine piece of service for the club to maintain and the directors agreed with him unanimously," Thurston said.
