

# RECORD LIST OF ENTRIES FILED FOR SWIM EVENTS

More Than 300 Swimmers Will Be Seen In Action At Star-Bulletin Swim

The 100 meter freestyle for women and the 800 meter freestyle for men, are the first two junior national A. A. U. events to be contested at the war memorial natatorium this afternoon. These two championships are part of the 22-event program arranged by the officials and The Star-Bulletin aquatic committee.

Three hundred and forty-three entries! Schools, "Y" clubs, organizations and special entries will vie for individual and team honors. The five place point scoring will make it possible for the schools to increase their lead or change positions.

Aliiolani school with over 100 juvenile entries is out to win the school point trophy offered in this special meet. The

half point allotted to each contestant who finishes a race regardless of time or position will give this school a very comfortable lead in the competitions.

The first event, the 50-meter freestyle for boys and girls under 13, is a swimming meet in itself. One hundred and forty-one youngsters will face the starter at promptly 2:15 and get off in the 14 assigned lanes.

There will be no heats. Every race will be a final event. The timers will determine the actual winner after all the tabulations are made. The best time made in each race will be announced.

The 120-yard individual medley for girls under 16 is an added event to give the girls in this age classification an opportunity to score points. This should be a great contest between Olga Clark, Ramona Clark, Elizabeth Toomey, and a few other girls from new representative schools.

### Many Relays

Thirty-three relay races! Juvenile swimmers from 8 to 16 years of age will splash through their 40 yards as a part of the 160-yard relay team. Ten teams will start at one time.

The 800-meter relay with Hui Makani, University of Hawaii, Outrigger C. C., Nuuanu Y. M. C. A., Fort De Russy, Fort Shafter, will be a record breaking event. The old association mark should go by the boards.

1—50-meter freestyle, girls under 13.

2—50-meter freestyle, boys under 13.

3—200-meter breaststroke, junior district championship.

4—100-meter freestyle, boys under
