

Firemen, Volley Loop Champs, to Show Tomorrow

Will Play Nuuanu 'Y' Sextet At Central 'Y' In Senior League Play

Tomorrow evening at the Central Y. M. C. A., the Senior A. A. U. Volleyball league will stage its second doubleheader of the season, and the rest of the four teams which have not played yet will be seen in action.

The first game starts at 7:30 o'clock with the Honolulu Firemen, who are 1929 champions making their first defense of their laurels against the Nuuanu Y. M. C. A. sextet. In the second contest, the Palama Settlement squad plays the Outrigger Canoe club beginning at 8:30 o'clock.

The Firemen have been practicing since they won the title last year and are in the pink of condition. They should have no great trouble downing the Nuuanu boys. The Palamas and the Outriggers should put up some great slamming. The Palamas are slight favorites.

Arthur Kempa, chairman of the volleyball committee, is contemplating starting the first game at 7:15 p. m. instead of 7:30 p. m. for the reason that in case three games are necessary to settle the first match which can be very frequent, the second match will not get going until maybe 9 p. m. The matter, however, has not been definitely settled.
