

Acme Swimming Meet Opens At Natatorium Wednesday Night

Close Competition In Many Events; Senior A. A. U. Titles Will Be At Stake In All Styles and Distances; Many Star Performers Will Be Seen In Action

The Acme aquatic carnival sponsored by the officials at McKinley, will feature for the first time in the history of the association, practically every event in which senior A. A. U. titles will be at stake or championship honors for the clubs or associations. This two night program will be held at the natatorium June 4 and 5 at 8 p. m.

Wednesday night promises to be a record breaking series of events. The long disputed question as to the strongest and fastest swimmer will be settled in the 440-yard Hawaiian championship. The three place winners, Maiola and Manuella Kallil with Maurice Furusho, all former freestyle association champions and Star-Bulletin one-mile swim paddlers, will find Buddie Crabbe one of the most serious contenders for the title.

The other entries of Sam Reid, John May, A. Hansen, K. Pratt, and a few others are unknown, as to their time ability and will not disturb the quartet which has been smashing the local records in the previous competitions. No race was held last year for time comparison, but Weissmuller made 4 minutes 52 seconds in the 1927 senior championships.

The 220-yard breaststroke championship for women will give the association a new record for that event. Lillie Bowmer May won the frog race last year in 3 minutes 49 seconds. Since that time Mae Westcott of the Women's Swimming Association has lowered that time consistently, and holds the record of 3 minutes 37 2-5 seconds.

The other entries of B. Hammond, L. Gillespie, have not been seen in that particular style of swimming this year. Mildred Slaght is capable of 3 minutes 44 seconds. It should be a great race.

The springboard diving for men, another Hawaiian championship, will bring together Vernon Harry of the University of Hawaii, one of our titleholders, and Richard Loutit of Battery A, who recently won the junior district championship. These two men should settle the senior diving supremacy. The other entries, Y. Kenjo, former association winner; R. Rath, C. Taark of the university, and S. Arakawa of Palama, have not been seen in open competition.
