

Special Races Kamehameha Day At Pearl Harbor

Stars, 18-Footers and S-Boats Will Compete In the Events

There will be special races over the Pearl Harbor Yacht club course on Wednesday, June 11, Kamehameha Day, for the H. M. Dowsett cup for the Star class yachts, the "Spike" Heyward cup for the 18-footers class, and the C. C. von Hamm cup for the S class.

The Star boats and 18-footers will sail over the Pearl Harbor course and the S boats will race from Pearl Harbor to Honolulu, finishing the race off the Moana hotel and making it a part of the Kamehameha Day festival and regatta sponsored by the Outrigger Canoe club and others. The first flag will go up at 10 a. m. at Pearl Harbor in order that the race will finish in time to allow participants to watch the other water sports that will be held off the Royal Hawaiian hotel in the afternoon.
