

BATHERS SOON TO HAVE GOLF LINKS AT BEACH

Sidney Schlank Prepares Miniature Course Between Moana and Outrigger

A wee golf course where one can play in bathing suit or street clothes is the latest innovation in Honolulu.

The course which has this attraction is the Moana Wee Golf course, which is under construction between the Moana hotel and the Outrigger Canoe club. It probably will open a week from Tuesday or Wednesday.

The course will have 18 holes and will involve the latest ideas its operator, Sidney Schlank, could obtain on the Pacific coast.

Schlank arrived from San Francisco about five weeks ago after having made a tour of southern California, inspecting more than 50 courses operated by a corporation in Los Angeles. He leased from the Moana hotel the 24,000 square feet that his course will cover.

Schlank stated today his course will have a bathers' entrance opening on the beach as well as a street entrance. This will permit persons enjoying the beach to vary their program with a round of golf, Schlank pointed out.

A clubhouse with a lanai and rest-rooms is under construction. The entire course is to be built with perfect continuity to permit play without confusion.

Felt fairways, the latest method of covering wee golf fairways, will be made possible through an order for 500 yards of felt that Schlank has put in.

The course will have four water holes. It will have a fountain 11 feet high, two large pools crossed by rustic bridges, and two streams running through the course to improve its appearance and develop water hazards.

There will be extensive landscaping with flowers and shrubs. Several palms have already been transplanted to the course. Shady seats, hibiscus hedges and other features will make the course very attractive, Schlank promises.

All clubs and balls will be sterilized each time they are used, he said in announcing his plans today.
