Surfboard Race For Malihinis Is Included In Sports For Sunday

Water sports at Waikiki Sunday will include a surfboard polo game between two picked Hui Nalu junior teams. The teams have been so selected as to make them of about equal strength, and an exciting match is promised.

In addition to the game, which is scheduled to start at 3:30 p. m., there will be a surfboard race for malihini men. There will also be a "cigar" board race from the Moana pier to Gray's beach, and back to the Royal Hawaiian.

The "cigar" boards are an innovation on the beach. They are long and narrow, and may be either solid or hollow.

An interesting surfboard polo game will be played on Saturday, April 12, at 2:30 p. m., for the benefit of the Malolo spring cruise passengers.

One team will be composed of the six Kahanamoku brothers, with Pua Kealoha, Jack Hjorth, Kino Guerero and John De Kaupiko, Jr.

The opposite team will be selected from Hui Nalu and Outrigger stars.
