

# ADD TWO EVENTS TO SURF RACES

## Classification of Hawaiian Type of Surfboards Made; Races Sunday

The citywide surfboard paddling committee has added two events to those already announced for the meet Sunday on the Ala Wai, it was revealed today. The events are the 100 yards for men and the 100 yards for women. Those who won first place in the Hawaiian championships held recently are not permitted in these two events.

All other races are for those who did not place in the championships.

The recreation commission's truck will be at the stonewall at 8 a. m., the public baths at 8:15 a. m. and at the Outrigger Canoe club at 8:30 a. m. to transport the boards and contestants to the Ala Wai for the races.

The classification committee on surfboard, headed by Knute Cottrell and assisted by Gay Harris, Vincent Genvis, Victor Ligda, Ben Oliveira and Arthur Powlison, announced that the Hawaiian type of surfboards have the following specifications:

### Surfboards

Not to exceed 12 feet in length.

Not to exceed three inches in thickness.

Not to be less than 18 inches at shoulder or pulling position.

Not to differ to any exaggerated extent from the style of the 16 inch coast artillery shell silhouette.

Not to be hollowed or changed in any way from the regular type surfing boards.

Not to be made of balsa or other special light material not generally used in regular surfing boards.
