up the challenge and with a final outburst of speed, beat his rival by one stroke. His time of 54 seconds flat broke the Hawaiian championship mark held by Crabbe by a 4-5 of a second.

However it was one and two-fifths seconds slower than Johnny Weismuller's American and Hawaiian record.

Ah Kong Pang broke the 220-yard breaststroke Hawaiian record when he negotiated the distance in 3 minutes 13-5 seconds, bettering the former mark by 24-5 seconds. Kong outclassed his rivals and won easily.

Hul Nalu outclassed the University team in the 220-yard club relay, and in doing so crashed the former record of 1:39:4 made by Outrigger in 1921. Hul Nalu's time last night was 1:39:3. The team was composed of Paoa, Sam Kahanamoku, Austin and Sargeant Kahanamoku.

Steele of the Navy broke the service 100 yard breaststroke mark when he swam the distance in 1 minute and 13 seconds. Jones of the Army held the former mark at 1 minute 16 seconds.
