

BUSTER CRABBE WINS 1500 METERS EVENT; MADISON IS VICTOR

LOS ANGELES, April 28.—Helene Madison, Seattle mermaid record breaker, and Buster Crabbe, Honolulu swimming star, were winners in swimming meets held here today.

Miss Madison won the 100-yard freestyle event in 1.02 2-5, beating Josephine McKim, U. S. C. co-ed star, by less than a foot in the women's A. A. U. championships here. Edna McKibben was third.

Eleanor Holm, N. Y. W. S. A., captured the women's 300-yard medley event in 4.27 2-10. Norene Forbes, L. A. A. C., was second, and Joan McSheehy, N. Y. W. S. A., third.

Crabbe swam to victory in the 1,500-meter freestyle race in the S. P. A. A. U. championships. His time was 20.27 4-10. Manuella Kalili was second and Herb Barthels, L. A. A. C., third.
