C. won the men's 800-yard relay event in 8.29 8-10. Another team from the same club was second, with Los Angeles funior college third. Helene Madison won the 500 yard freestyle and smashed a world's record in doing it. Her time was 6:35 2/10, and lowered her own mark of 6:43 2/10. Susan Robertson, Women's Swimming Association of New York, was second and Norene Forbes, Los Angeles Athletic Club, third. Buster Crabbe won the 800 meter freestyle event, covering the distance in 10:43 8/10 for the Southern California title. Herb Barthels was sec-
