

Surprises, Fast Times In Star-Bulletin Swims

Surprises and fast times were chalked up in yesterday's Memorial Day swims, sponsored by the local A. A. U., at the Waikiki War natatorium.

In the featured events of the day, The Star-Bulletin swims, one new record was established when Harold Sexton of the Outrigger Canoe club splashed his way to first place in the one mile junior race. Sexton's time was 23 minutes 57 4-5 seconds.

This time was only 32 4-5 seconds slower than the senior one mile contest which was won by Jack May of the Hui Makani in 23 minutes 25 seconds.

Miss Gladys Slaght of the Outrigger Canoe club took the half mile swim for women by churning through the water in 13 minutes 54 3-5 seconds. The winners were awarded prizes by The Star-Bulletin.

Large Crowd Present

A large and enthusiastic crowd saw the events, as well as the pre-Olympic competitions which followed.

Johnny Woodd, swimming in the 100 meters freestyle, paddled to first place in the good time of 60 seconds. He finished about three yards ahead of Sergeant Kahana-moku, who nosed out Buddie Crabbe

for third place.

Woodd also took the 50 meters freestyle, defeating Crabbe by a yard. His time was 26 2-5 seconds.
