Outrigger survives protest to stay unbeaten

Outrigger Canoe Club overcame its biggest challenge of the paddling season — a protest over its new ama (outrigger float) to win yesterday's John D. Kaupiko Regatta on Kaneohe Bay.

Outrigger scored 83 points for its sixth win of this Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association season, with Kailua finishing second with 57 and host Hui Nalu 45.

In the A division (less than 16 crews), Leeward Kai edged Waiki-

ki Surf, 19-17, with Hui Lanakila in third with 16.

The protest came over the use of a new ama designed by OCC's Walter Guild that had been fiberglassed and painted, resembling a non-traditional ama for its koa canoe Kaolaa. Surfsports contended that the ama was not made of native Hawaiian wood, a requirement to compete in OHORA. A hole was drilled and it was determined the new ama was legal.

OCC had two crews continue undefeated seasons in its women's senior masters (45-and-older) and 16 girls.

The OHORA championships are scheduled for next Sunday at Keehi Lagoon, beginning at 8:30 a.m.

■ **Hui Wa'a:** Lokahi, gearing up to defend its association's title this weekend, took an easy win yesterday at the Waikiki Beach Boys Invitational at Waikiki Beach. Lokahi won the AA division with

68 points, followed by Manu O Ke Kai's 48 and Ka Mo'i with 44.

In the A division (fewer than 16 crews), Koa Kai edged Windward Kai for the trophy, 23-22. It was the third straight victory at Waikiki for Lokahi and its fifth outright title of this season.

Hui Wa'a clubs will compete in their Oahu championships Saturday at Keehi Lagoon, also beginning at 8:30 a.m.

Winners of next weekend's OHORA and Hui Wa'a individual races qualify for the state championship, Aug. 4, at Hanalei.

Charles A. Guard, retired executive

Charles A. "Fat" Guard, who was known for his lifelong interest in Hawaiian music, died July 17, 1990, at Kaiser Hospital. He was 71.

He retired from the U.S. Naval Reserve as a lieutenant commander and retired from the stevedoring business as an assistant manager and director of Honolulu Terminals.

Born and raised in the family home on Armstrong Street in Manoa, Guard was a Punahou School alumnus who went on to study at Loomis Institute, University of Maine and the University of Washington.

He served in the Navy until 1945 and in the reserve until 1965, and was active for years in the Hawaii chapter of Navy League. He also was a member of the Pacific Club, Outrigger Canoe Club and Central Union Church.

He is survived by his wife, Carolyn; daughter, Marilee Hurlman of Oregon; son, Charles Jr. of Kula, Maui; sister, Barbara Sheehan of Maui; brothers, Richard and Robert T., and grandchildren.
