

# Swim Stars A Main Portion Of Meet Plan Now In View

Duke, Pua, Warren and Harris Are Willing To Head Teams For a 'School Tank' Fund

A SWIMMING benefit, in behalf of the first school to take advantage of The Advertiser's swimming pool offer and express its willingness to undertake the raising of the pool fund, is now planned by local swim supporters.

As a headline feature, considered to be one of undoubted drawing power, a four-team competition, between teams captained by Duke Kahana-mokū, Bill Harris, Warren Kealoha and Pua Kealoha respectively, is planned for the occasion.

The four swimming stars have consented to take part in the affair and to lend their energies to putting it over the top in any way possible, so there is every likelihood that the meet will be staged in the near future.

The plan at present includes fancy and plain diving exhibitions, an exhibition race between the four leaders and others, plunge exhibitions, races for all classes of entries and a snappy relay contest.

It is hoped to secure Punahou tank for the purpose, it being believed that under the circumstances Punahou will be glad to assist a sister institution in obtaining what it has already obtained through the generosity of certain citizens—an up-to-date swimming tank.

The school chosen for the offer will receive the net proceeds of the meet, and these will be applied to the swimming tank fund, which should be thus started off with a good-sized nest-egg.

No date has been set for the affair, as the present plans are purely tentative.
