

MERMAID SWIM MEET POSTPONED TO APRIL

The fourth annual Hawaiian swimming meet for women has been postponed again, this time until April 29. The date originally was March 18 and then March 25, but yesterday afternoon it was decided to hold it on the final Saturday in April.

The reason is because the Punahou pool being located in a rain belt, has much inclement weather in March but less of it in April. It will also give the swimmers a chance to get in some training.
